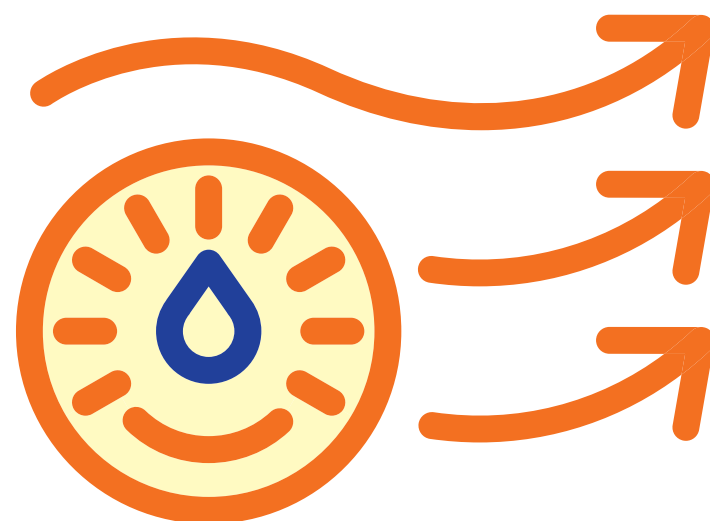


Warm spaces in Arun
